Theme variables are used to change the theme as you can see on this page: You can change the color from background-color: \$primary-3; To background-color: #ee5b5b; Because you want a lighter color. Note that you can create your own variables: \$mq-small: #ee5b5b; \$mq-medium: #ee6e6e; \$mq-large: #eecece; With that you could create the variable like so: background-color: \$mq-small; What I would recommend is to create a theme with only one color. Make it your primary color and then you can use your variables to change what color you would like. See the example here:
